Tour Information: The Boating and Waterways Commission will conduct a tour as detailed on the attached Tour Agenda, which may also be found at www.parks.ca.gov/notices. The tour is open to the public. Tour participants will meet at the Residence Inn-Marriott Hotel, 2618 Gateway Oaks Drive, Sacramento, California 95833, at 8 AM. Members of the public shall provide their own transportation to the Residence Inn-Marriott Hotel. DBW will provide transportation for the tour from the hotel site and return participants to the hotel site from the last tour site. The tour group will travel to various locations along the Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta, including one site located in Contra Costa County. The tour will last approximately 7-8 hours and will involve considerable walking over uneven terrain. Layered clothing, sturdy footwear, hats or caps, and sunscreen are recommended. Participants are encouraged to be prepared with sufficient food and water supplies.
