THIS ORDER SUPERSEDES ORDER NO. 690-057-2024

Temporary Closure- Culvert Trail

Effective 2024 February 20th, Culvert Trail is closed to all public access between the intersection of Fuel Break Trail and Old Foresthill Road for maintenance and repairs.

The closure is for the protection of the public and work crew at Auburn State Recreation Area. The Culvert Trail will be closed until further notice and or until repairs are made.

Exceptions:

1. Employees, officers, contractors, lessees, and permittees of the State Department of Parks and Recreation and the US Bureau of Reclamation entering the area on official business.
2. Those non-employees accompanied by the above-described officials who may be in the area on official business.

This order is in effect for the health and safety of persons, property, and resources.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Gold Fields District Superintendent at 7755 Folsom-Auburn Road, Folsom, CA 95630.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
