DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S ORDER NUMBER:

940-15-002

1. No person shall launch, land, or operate a powered unmanned aircraft or Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) within Anza-Borrego Desert State Park®, Cuyamaca Rancho State Park, Salton Sea State Recreation Area, Palomar Mountain State Park, Picacho State Recreation Area, and Indio Hills Palms Property. Exceptions to this directive may include the following:
 - A. Commercial filming with the proper permitting for the use of a UAS or other aircraft.
 - B. Use by law enforcement under exigent circumstances with direct permission of the District Superintendent.
 - C. Scientific research conducted with direct permission of the District Superintendent.
 - D. Other uses exempted by the District Superintendent by application.
2. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Colorado Desert District, 200 Palm Canyon Drive, Borrego Springs, CA 92004-5005.
3. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contracts or property rights.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions by law.
