



Vessels Involved in All Accidents by Length






Gender of Operators Involved in Accidents



Type of Vessels Operated by Men **Involved in Accidents**




Type of Vessels Operated by Women Involved in Accidents






Accidents Involving Towing Sports*




*Towing sports include persons being towed on lines behind vessels on water skis, wakeboards, wake skates, kneeboards, skurf boards, tubes and parasails.

Two of the accidents involved two vessels participating in different types of tow sports. Consequently 108 vessels involved in tow sports were involved in 106 accidents.











2009 California Recreational Boating Fatalities by Location




