

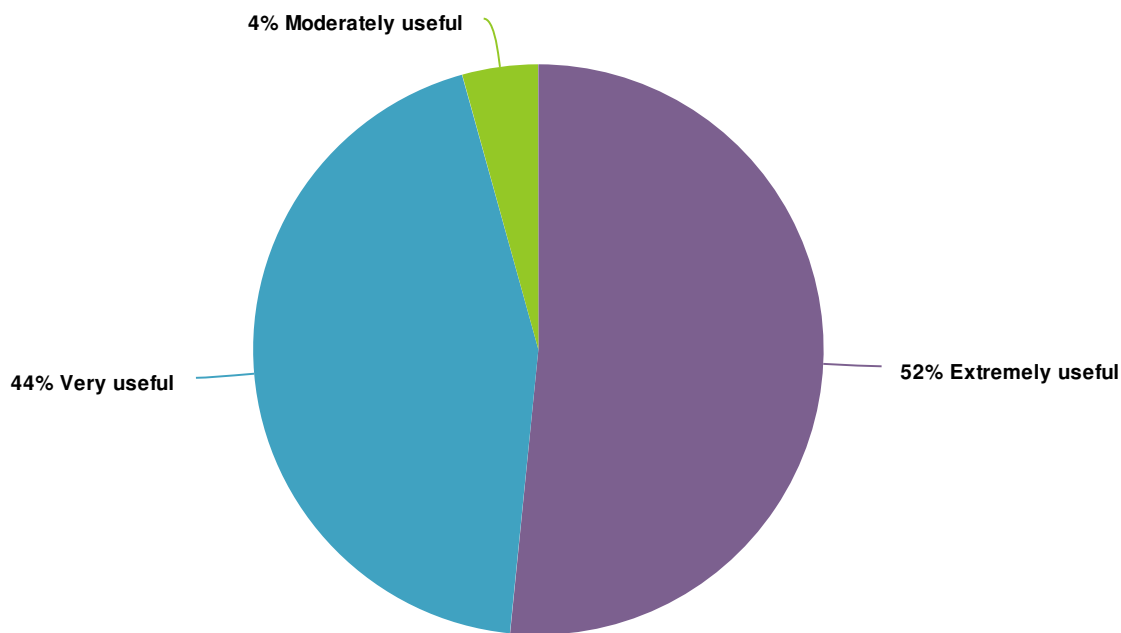

1. Based on your experience, how useful was the Dockwalker training in providing you with valuable information and preparation for your own Dockwalking outreach efforts?

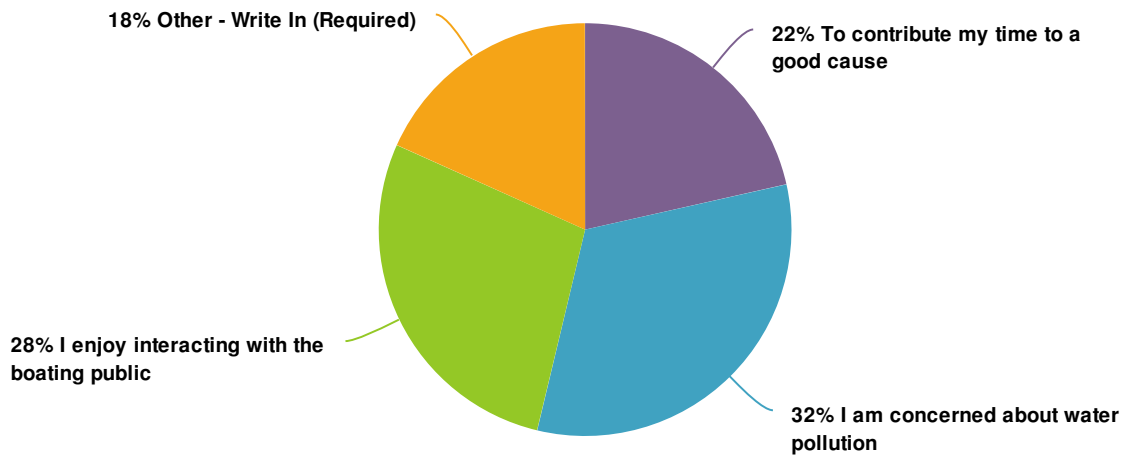

2. What was your primary motivation in participating in the Dockwalker program?



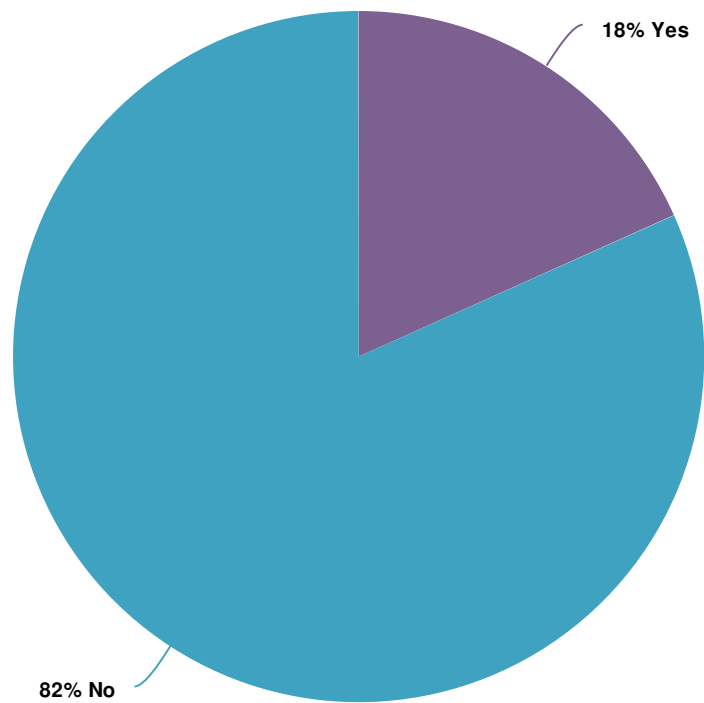

3. Did you have any trouble conducting your Dockwalking activity?

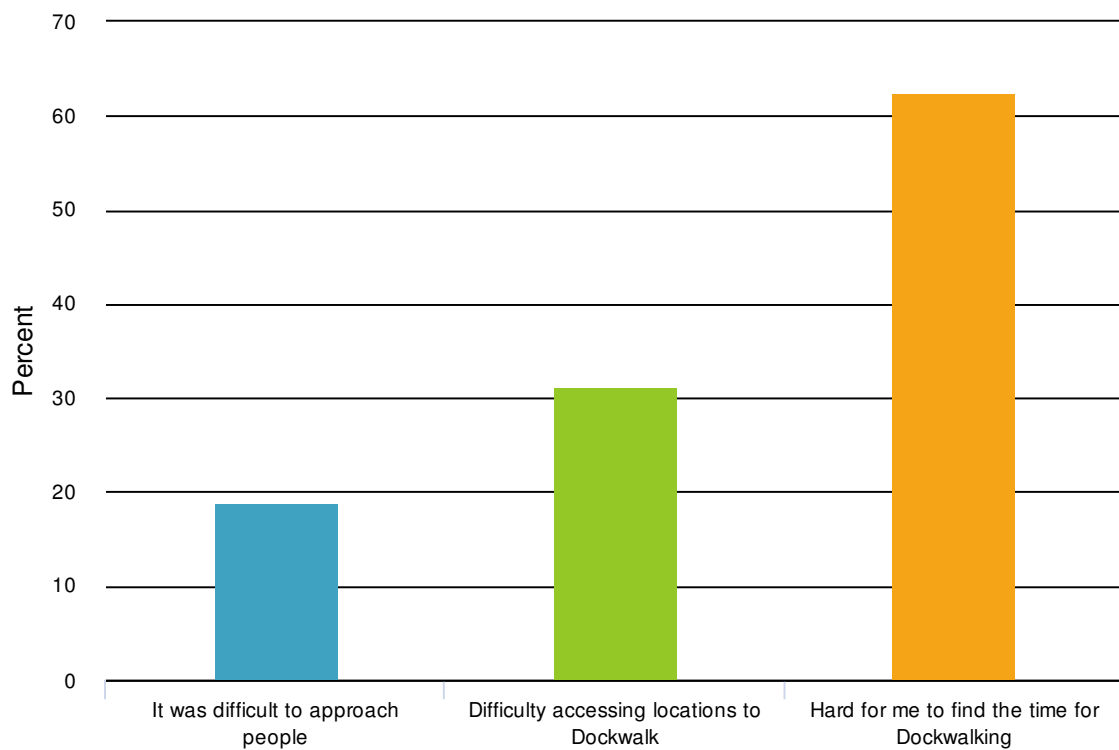

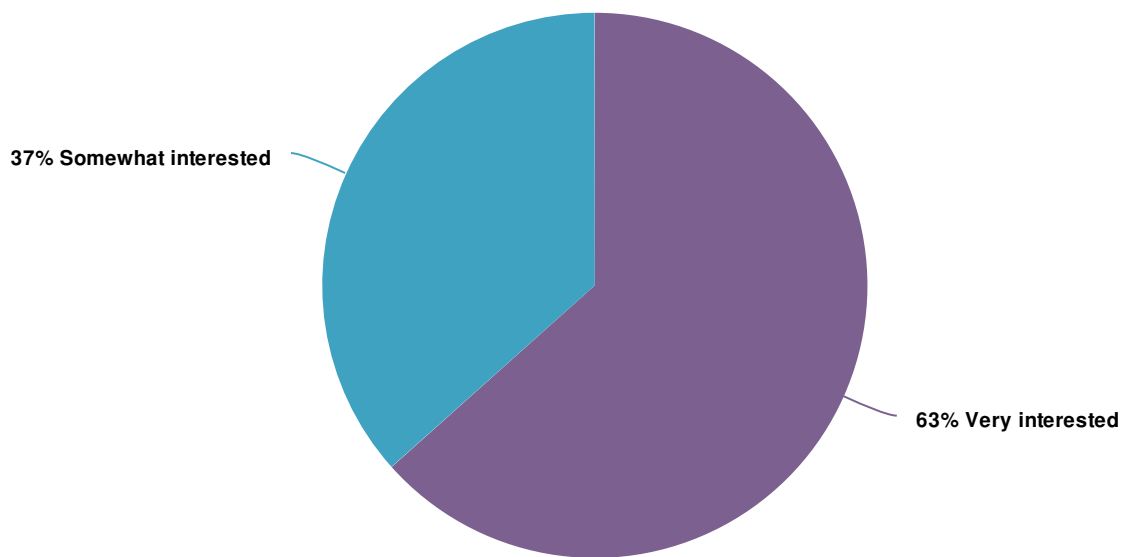

5. How did boaters respond to your face-to-face boater education and the boater kits?

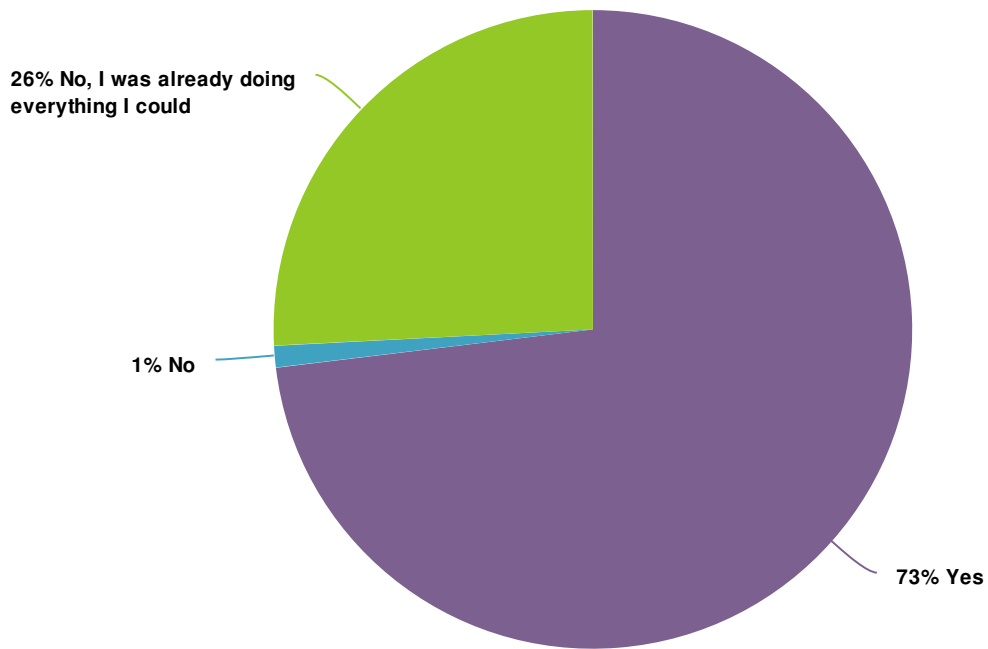

6. Has participating in the Dockwalker program motivated you personally to be more environmentally-friendly?

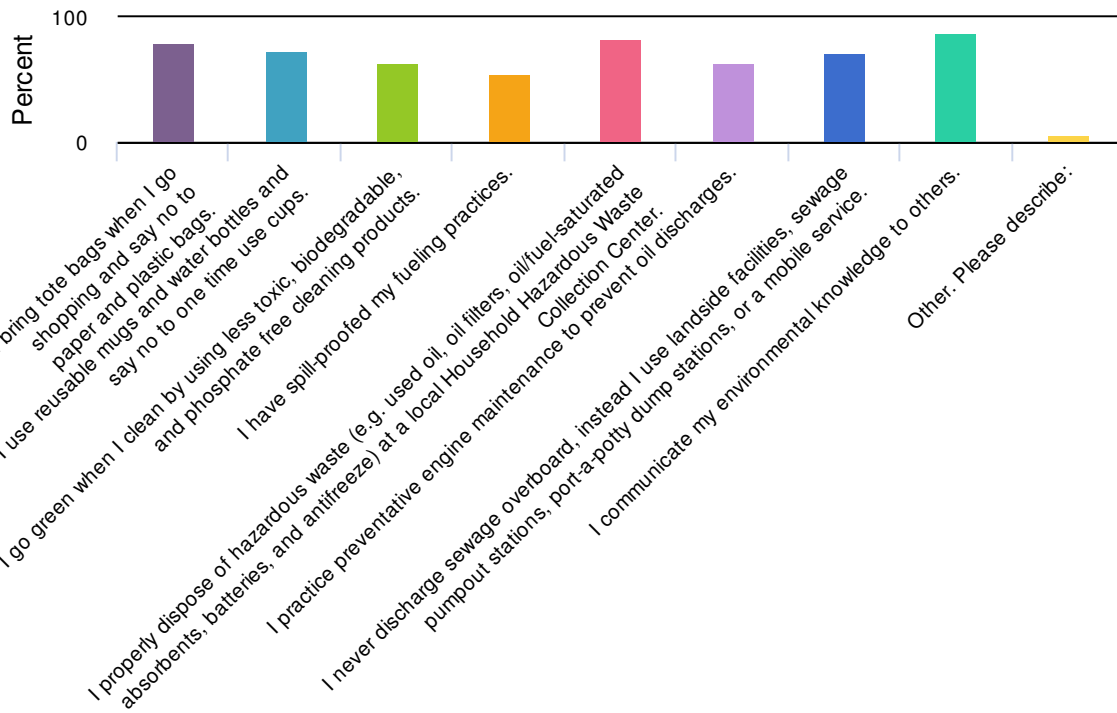
